

INTRODUCTION

This is now the fourteenth year of the Metropolitan Police Five-a-Side Youth Football Competition, which is recognised by the "Guinness Book of Records" as the largest five-a-side football tournament in the world. Last year, some 100,000 people, including parents, supporters, and players were involved, and over 4,000 teams took part.

Some of the 'young people' who have taken part in past years have gone on to higher things, such as John Barnes, Tony Cottee, David Rocastle, and Michael Thomas.

Today, we are seeing the Finals for the London Borough of Wandsworth, and the winning teams will go forward to represent the Borough at the Quarter-Finals for the whole of London at Imber Court Sports Club, East Molesey in September. The Grand Finals will take place at Wembley Arena in November.

Within this Borough, over 140 teams took part in the preliminary rounds of the Competition, playing in seven age groups, four for boys, three for girls, covering the ages of 9 to 17 years.

As Co-ordinator of the Competition for this Borough, I must take this opportunity to give special thanks to many people who have given their time and effort to help with the running of the event, and these are listed later in the programme. I hope that there is no-one who I have forgotten, but if there is, I can only apologise and say that it is not intentional! However, a special vote of thanks must go to all the referees who have given their time freely, and without whose help, the competition could not have been played at all. Also, Al Busa, who was responsible for all the playing arrangements for the preliminary rounds and the Finals tonight.

One last word must be said for the players and managers. In the present climate where the media make the most of any problem with players and fans, I would like to say that our weekend of football in Garratt Park in June, the behaviour of players, managers, and supporters gave no problem to anyone, apart from one very minor incident. Out of about 250 games, that is not bad going. Thankyou to all those for making it a very enjoyable time.
